Mammy Slaght became purchaser thereof for the sum of Twenty one dollars and Sixty cents and in consideration of which sum the above named Commissioners have and do by these presents convey to him the said Exam Nick his heirs and assigns all the right title interest and Estate which was transferred to us by the decree aforesaid for sum the said Exam Nick his heirs and assigns to hold forever unto Mammy Slaght wherefore we the above named Commissioners have herein set our hands and affixed our seals that 21st day of March 1829

Southampton County December Court 1828 Decreed by the said Court and in conformity therewith the Wm Mammy Slaght Alfred Story and Joel Nick Commissioners named thereto have on the 19th day of January in the year 1829 sold at auction the Lot of Land assigned to Exam Nick by commissioners in the division of the Lands of which Jacob Nick died seized and possessed lying on the west side of Bottomay River and Richard Jordan another Lot of the said tract of Land assigned him when he same ministered that aforesaid and for which Lot of Land he the said Richard Jordan have received of Exam Nick in his life time full and satisfactory pay for the same non therefore and to the same and that the heirs of the said Exam Nick etc may receive and enjoy equally the benefits of the said Lot of Land he the said Richard Jordan in conjunction with the above named Commissioners in like manner shall also the lot of Land assigned him said Jordan or mammy aforesaid and William Cutler then became purchaser of both the said lots of Land for both of which he the said William Cutler gave the sum of Fifteen Dollars and Forty five Cents the number of acres contained in each Lot and the boundaries of the same were appurtenant to the Commissioners report on the division of the lands of Jacob Nick etc which is of record in the Clerks office for the County of Southampton and in consideration of the sum aforesaid to us the above named Commissioners had we the said Commissioners and Richard Jordan have and do hereby convey to the said William Cutler his heirs and assigns all the right title interest and Estate which was transferred to us by the decree aforesaid and the said Richard Jordan and his heirs the sum aforesaid Estate which he had purchased in the one lot of the above described land to himself and William Cutler and his heirs and assigns to have and to hold the said two Lots
