This Indenture made and entered into this 18th day of February 1829 between James Newcome of the first part and Joseph T. Clark of the second part Witnesseth that the said Newcome for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Joseph T. Clark before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both by said said and to be conveyed and assigned to him the said Joseph T. Clark all the right title and interest which pertains in Richard Barron as husband and wife of his said wife Elizabeth one of the heirs and devisees of Jesse Clark deceased and to all the negroes which stand allotted to Mrs. Nancy P. Clark widow of the said Jesse Clark deceased as her dower with them in case which interest hath been sold and conveyed by the said Richard Barron to the said Newcome To have and to hold to him the said Joseph T. Clark and to his heirs and assigns the said right title and interest in reversion or remainder forever to him the said Newcome back unto set his hand and seal this 18th day of February 1829

Miller and Abraham both became her sureties ~~for~~ above debt Now the above mentioned Mary Ann Harcome being desirous to discharge and secure the above named secured her more especially for the sum of one dollar to her in hand paid by the said Simon Murphey before the undersigned and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that the said Mary Ann Harcome hath granted bargained and sold unto the said Simon Murphey one negro man born to him and his heirs forever and his
