This Indenture made and entered into this first day of June A.D. 1829 Between
 Benjamin Westra and Polly his wife of the County of Southampton of the first part and
 John Muguet & Richard B. Baker and William Reddison of the third part whereas the said Benjamin Westra being partly
 indebted to John Muguet in the sum of one hundred dollars due by note and account
 to Richard B. Baker in the sum of Fifty dollars due by note with interest from the 1st of
 June 1829 and to William Reddison in the sum of Twenty dollars with interest
 from the first of June 1829 due by note and the said Benjamin Westra being willing
 and desirous to secure the payment of the aforesaid sums of money held with his wife
 Polly Westra conveyed to the property herein after mentioned to the said James B. Muguet
 trust to be sold for that purpose hereon therefore the Indenture witnesseth that
 that the said Benjamin Westra and Polly his wife for and in consideration of
 the premises aforesaid and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to the
 said Benjamin in hand paid by the said James B. Muguet at or before the executing
 and delivery of these presents she receipt whereof the said Benjamin Westra & Polly his
 wife do hereby acknowledge they the said Benjamin Westra and Polly his wife having
 granted bargained and sold alighted in scoff and confirmed and by these presents do give
 grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said James B. Muguet
 and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and
 being in the County of Southampton and containing by estimation fifty four acres
 more or less it being the tract of Land wherewith the said Benjamin Westra and wife
 reside to have and to hold the said tract of land and premises with its appurtenances
 unto him the said James B. Muguet and his heirs and assigns forever against
 the claim of them the said Benjamin Westra and Polly his wife or their successors
 and against the lawful claim of all and every person or persons whomsoever upon
 this special trust and condition nevertheless that the said James B. Muguet
 shall permit the said Benjamin Westra and Polly his wife to remain in quiet and
 peaceable possession of the said tract of Land and premises with its appurtenances
 and to take the profits thereof to their own use until disposed by him as in the beginning
 of the aforesaid sum of money hereby intended to be secured or either of them and
 whereupon this further trust that if the said Benjamin Westra shall fail to pay on
 or before the day of to the said John Muguet, Richard B. Baker
 and William Reddison the sum of money herein especially including what may
 which may have accrued thereon then and in that case it shall and may be lawfully
 for the said John Muguet, Richard B. Baker and William Reddison or
 either of them to direct the said James B. Muguet to make sale of the tract of Land
 and premises aforesaid with its appurtenances and the said James B. Muguet
 upon receiving such direction shall within twenty days give notice by publick place
 previous publick notice by advertisement to be set up at one or more publick places
 in the neighbourhood proceed to sell at publick auction to the highest bidder on
 the premises the aforesaid tract of land with its appurtenances for cash and out
 of the proceeds in the first place pay all costs incurred in the execution of these
 presents in the second place pay to the parties of the third part the sum of money
 respectively due them in the manner in which they are named in this deed and in
 the third place pay the overplus if any to the said Benjamin Westra or his legal
 representative And the said Benjamin Westra and Polly his wife do hereby
 covenant to warrant and defend unto the said James B. Muguet his heirs
 the right and title to the aforesaid tract of Land and premises with its appurte-
 nances against the claim of them the said Benjamin Westra and Polly his wife or
 either of them or of them or either of them heirs or assigns and against the claim right title
 interest or demand of all and every person or persons whomsoever In Testimony
