 certain Tract of Land ^{more or less} being that part of land accorded to her the said Elizabeth
 Turner from her deceased father's Estate containing one hundred and twelve acres be
 the same more or less and bounded by the lands of the late Edward Pate and others to
 her and to hold the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging
 to him the said Alex Pate and as aforesaid her heirs Executors and assigns forever
 and the said Elizabeth Turner for herself and her heirs Executors and assigns
 Covenant and agree to and with the said Alexander Pate his heirs and assigns
