the second part and James Rockwell and the said John Thomas
of the third part and the said James Rockwell in his own individual capacity of the third part
Witness that whereas the said George F. Shirley stands indebted to the estate of John
Thomas dec^d in several sums of money and the said John Thomas being security for the
said George F. Shirley in several Bonds or notes made payable to Lawrence Cook
son of Lucetta Cook dec^d one made payable to Robert Porters and of Henry Thon
dec^d one made payable to Sampson Priory and several other debts not more recited
and whereas the said James Rockwell is security for the said George F. Shirley in a note executed to
John Pickett one other note executed to William Pickett and one other note executed to the
said William Pickett amounts or dates not particularly recited and the said George F. Shirley
