 to a certain tract of land whereof John Rochee the elder died seized and possessed
 which said tract of Land lies near the Chickadee Bridge and which contains four
 hundred and forty acres more or less and is bounded by the lands of James O'Hanlon
 The lands of Richard or John Fitch the lands of Newman Edwards Drury Gault
 George or John W. Gurley or others To have and to hold the interest of us and to his
