This Indenture made and entered into this 20th day of July 1829 between Fugard Bryant of the first part Samuel Wells of the second part and Rich P Strong of the third part whereas the said Fugard Bryant is indebted to the above named Rich P Strong & Co in the first sum of Three hundred and forty nine dollars & 50^{cts} due by bond of Equal date herewith and is desirous to secure the payment of the same to himself from that Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Wells before the said Strong & Co any of these two on the said day the said Fugard Bryant hath bargained sold and delivered and by these presents doth bargain sell and deliver unto the said Wells one negro woman named Maney and one mulatto boy named Watson to have and to hold to her only proper use and behoof for ever upon Trust nevertheless that the said Fugard Bryant is to retain possession of the said woman Maney and boy Watson until the said Rich P Strong & Co or their assigns shall or shall direct the said Wells (a or his executors or assigns) to take possession of the same and after duly advertising the same for twenty days the said Wells as Trustee shall appraise shall sell the said woman Maney and boy Watson or either of them at market price to satisfy the debt and interest aforesaid to the highest bidder for cash and of the proceeds of such sale pay first the expenses of the said indenture the Debt aforesaid with the interest which may have accrued thereon and the balance of any pay to the said Fugard Bryant or his Order But if the said Fugard Bryant at any time before the said sale shall have been made shall pay the said Strong & Co their dues or assigns the said sum of money with the interest thereon and the costs hereof if the said Strong & Co covenant that the said woman Maney and boy Watson shall be fully released to him the said Fugard Bryant of this indenture and of the said Bryant and his assigns if said his said covenant is that the said woman Maney and boy Watson shall be delivered up for these purposes whenever applied for In Testimony whereof the said several parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first herein written
