sum of Three hundred and forty five dollars & 50 pence by bond of equal date hereto and  
and was desirous to secure the payment of the same to him aforesaid. In testimony whereof  
that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him aforesaid  
paid by the said Kello before the sealing and delivery of these presents to the said George  
Bryant such bargained sold and delivered and by these presents doth bargain and  
deliver unto the said Kello one negro woman named Nancy and one mulatto boy  
named Watson to have and to hold to his only proprie and school forever upon  
trust never to sell that the said George Bryant is to retain possession of the said  
woman Nancy and boy Watson and the said Rich R Strong Esq or their assigns  
or at the shall direct the said Kello or his executors or administrators to take possession of the said  
and after duly advertising and place of sale for twenty days the said Kello as trustee  
aforesaid shall sell the said woman Nancy and boy Watson or either of them as may be  
necessary to satisfy the debt and interest aforesaid to the highest bidder for cash and of  
the proceeds of such sale pay first the expenses of the trust to the said Peter for and with the  
interest which may have accrued thereon and the balance if any pay to the said George  
Bryant on his Order But if the said George Bryant at any time before he said sale  
shall have been made shall pay the said Strong Esq then thus or signs the sum of  
money with the intent thereon and the said hereof shall have given to the said  
that the said woman Nancy and boy Watson shall be fully released to him by
