Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full term of Five thousand Dollars to which payment well and truly to be made to the said Governor for the time being and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally jointly by these presents sealed with our hands and dated this 20th day of July 1829

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Samuel Wells has been duly appointed by the County Court of Southampton to serve as Constable in the lower district of Northampton Parish in the County of Southampton for two years from this day forth if the said Samuel Wells shall well and truly discharge the duties of the said Office of Constable in the said County during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue
