This Indenture made this 10 day of July in the year 1829 between Jameson Little and Eliza his wife of Southampton County of the one part and John James of Southampton County of the other part witnesseth that the said Jameson Little and Eliza his wife in consideration of seven hundred and five current money of Virginia to them in hand paid at or before the making and delivery of these presents have bargain and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said John James his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land lying on either ay river and bounded as follow Viz Beginning at a corner tree between said lands and a raney James thence down the river to a white oak a corner tree between the said land and my original tract thence a straight line to a mulberry a corner tree between said land and Amos Drake thence a straight line to a black gum a corner between the said land and Charles Merghant land thence down the run of the branch to a broad top Cypress a corner tree between the said land and a raney James thence a straight line to the beginning this tract is said to contain two hundred and fifty seven acres and is sold for that sum more or less this tract of land contains two hundred and fifty seven more or less is sold for the sum of seven hundred dollars together with the reversion and reversion remainders and reversions of each and other trees species and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said sum of two hundred and fifty seven acres more or less of land bounded as have been before mentioned unto the said John James his heirs and assigns forever and the said Jameson Little and Eliza his wife for themselves and the said sum of two hundred and fifty acres of land more or less with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John James his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of whom the said Jameson Little or Eliza his wife or either them or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons who claim shall will and do in warrant and force or defense by these presents Witnessed whereof the said Jameson Little and Eliza his wife have hereunto set their hands and date the day and year first above written
