Coker Executor of Moses Hart dec^d for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand
and thirty one dollars and 4th of 100 cents lawful money of Virginia to him the said Jordan
Coker Esq^r in hand well and truly paid or thereunto secured the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged; he the said Jordan Coker Esq^r hath granted bargained and
sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John Williams on
his heirs and assigns the land and plantation which Moses Hart dec^d seized and possessed
of containing eighty one acre the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Arthur
McCollum John Virgeland and others and also all said woods in demesnes ways profits
commodities advantages hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said land
and plantation above mentioned belonging or in any wise appertaining and the re-
version and reversions remainder and remainders rents issues and profits of the
the said premises and of every part and parcel thereof and all the estate right title and
interest claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Jordan Coker Executor of
Moses Hart dec^d of in and to the said land and plantation and every part thereof
To have and to hold the said land and plantation and every part and parcel
thereof with the appurtenances unto the said John Williams on his heirs and
assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said John Williams on his heirs &
assigns forever And the said Jordan Coker Esq^r of Moses Hart dec^d for himself
the said land and plantation and every part thereof against himself as Esq^r of Moses
Hart dec^d to the said John Williams on his heirs and assigns shall and will war-
rant and forever defend by these presents I Witness whereof the said Jordan

Known all men by these presents that Richard Davis of the County of Southampton
Sho. for and in consideration of the sum of thirty five dollars lawful money of Virginia
to me in hand paid by Joseph T. Haud of Southampton County Virginia at and before the
sealing and delivering of these presents (the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge)
have bargained sold granted and confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell grant and
confirm to the said Joseph T. Haud all my interest claim or right which I have or may have
in a certain negro slave named Sterling which slave is one of the domestic slaves of Lucy
Pansy which was loaned her by Richard Harrison and then to be delivered according
to his will To have and to hold the said negro slave Sterling to the only proper use and
behoof of the said Joseph T. Haud his Executors administrators and assigns forever
And I the said Richard Davis for my self my Executors adm^r of the said negro slave
Sterling to the said Joseph T. Haud his Executors administrators of and against all and every
other person or persons who hereafter shall and will warrant and forever defend by these
