 This Indenture made this 1st day of July 1829 between Benjamin Griffen Trustee of the
 first part, Charles B. Gold the debtor of the second part, and Owen A. Ricks agent for James
 Stanton, creditor of the third part, whereas the said Charles B. Gold on the 19th day of
 March in the year of our Lord 1827 in order to secure the payment of the sum of one thousand
 sixty two dollars forty two cents to the said James Stanton, did by Indenture of Lease of that date
 coming to the said Benjamin Griffen his true Executor and administrator the following property
 seventy and two thirds acres of land (regular with survey articles of personal estate which
 had been sold) upon trust for the use and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned
 and whereas since the executing and delivery of the said deed of Trust the said Charles B. Gold
 hath fully satisfied and paid to the said Owen A. Ricks agent for the said James Stanton
 the sum of money therein secured which the said Owen A. Ricks doth hereby acknowledging
 Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for the consideration aforesaid as well for the
 further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Benjamin Griffen at or before
 the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 by the said Benjamin Griffen with the assent of the said Owen A. Ricks, as agent for
 signified by his being a party to these presents and the said Owen A. Ricks Agent having granted
 bargained and sold, conveyed, released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and
 sell release and confirm unto the said Charles B. Gold, all the right title interest claim and
 demand both at Law and Equity which the said Benjamin Griffen have or hold in the land
 above described To Have and To Hold the said tract or parcel of land above described
 to the said Charles B. Gold, his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever to the only
 proper use and behoof of him the said Charles B. Gold, his heirs &c. forever And the said
 Benjamin Griffen for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the above mentioned
 land unto the said Charles B. Gold his heirs Executors administrators and assigns in as full and
 ample manner as the same was warranted by the said Charles B. Gold, by the deed of this
 above recited do warrant the same to the said Charles B. Gold against the claim or
 claims of him the said Benjamin Griffen and all persons claiming the by or under him
