This Indenture made this 17th of July 1829 between John Summer of the first part
and Joseph French of the second part and Joseph Murray of the third witnesseth that
I James P French and in consideration of Joseph Murray's having to come to appear and to give his
Summer in a sum of £100⁰⁰ Summer against him for about fifty dollars and the said
Summer being anxious to be rid of my and save free from all loss whatever the said
Joseph Murray shall in consideration of the promise as well as for the further sum of one
dollar, in hand to him paid at or before the making and delivery of this present shall
bargain grant and hold and by these presents doth grant thysm and all unto the said
James P French his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit one Mahogany Chair
pref work about 60 dollars and a Mahogany Case worth about 30 dollars Upon this
Nevertheless that if the said John Summer should fail to attend at the Law Days
and the said Joseph Murray have to pay the said sum of about fifty dollars each
by the said James P French then the said James P French shall proceed to sell the said
property having advanced it a reasonable time and apply it to the payment of the sum
advanced by the said Joseph Murray the remainder to go to Mr Summer his heirs

property now in my possession to which I am entitled without exception To have and
hold the said property unto him she said Henry Hudson his heirs Executors administrators
and assigns upon condition that he said property shall be allowed to remain upon the same
in the possession of the said Henry Hudson and provided I have the use of it
during my natural life and the said Sarah Hudson for herself her heirs Executors
against the claim or claims of her the said Sarah Hudson and against the claim or claims of
all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and wills warrant and forever after
