This Agreement made this 17th day of August 1829 in year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty nine between Jacob Williams and Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Rhoda Worrell of the said County of the other part witnesseth that the said Jacob Williams and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds and twenty five dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Rhoda Worrell the receipt whereof the said Jacob Williams and Nancy his wife doth hereby acknowledge both grants bargains sales and conveyances by these presents with quiet hancies held and convey to the said Rhoda Worrell her husband aforesaid a certain tract or parcel of Land containing dimensions and there fourths be the same more or less lying and being in County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a small pine standing in Thomas Anderson woods line a corner for John Evans three threes a straight line to a pine ^{more} known as corner in said ^{line} stand a small branch to small pine a north corner for Rhoda Worrell and Jacob Williams thence a straight line of market trees to said underwood and thence down said line to the Beginning containing fourteen and fourty acres to the same more or less to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances there belonging to her the said Rhoda Worrell her heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Rhoda Worrell her heirs or assigns for and during the life of the said Jacob Williams and Nancy his wife for them selves their executors and administrators with his wife Covenant and agree to and with the said Rhoda Worrell and assigns that the said Jacob Williams and Nancy his wife another time shall by tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto her the said Rhoda Worrell her heirs and assigns against them the said Jacob Williams and Nancy his wife and their heirs and against all persons whomsoever shall and will by this instrument forever remain and be witnesseth whereof the the said Jacob Williams and Nancy his wife have hereunto set their hands and affix their seals the this day and year above written
