Third Indenture made the 20th day of July 1829 Between Nicholas Mugt of the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and William R Battie of
 the County of Stafford and State of North Carolina of the second part WITNESSETH that
 for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand and thirty three dollars and
 money of the state of Virginia to him the said Nicholas Mugt in hand paid or
 secured to be paid by the said William R Battie at or before the concluding and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Nicholas
 Mugt has granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and
 sell to the said William R Battie his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel
 of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton at Burying that pond
 or lot of land in which fell to his share in the division of the land belonging to the
 Estate of Nicholas Mugt deceased adjoining the lots belonging to Angelina (Mugt) William
 D Mugt and said William R Battie containing 85 acres and thereon in certain divisions
 as follows Beginning at a pine on the path in John Hargrave's
 line thence N.W. 1/4 pole to a willow oak in a branch thence down said branch S.S.
 W 1/4 pole to a corner sum. N. 88 W 21 pole to a white oak S. 78. W 24. to the top of a knoll
 thence up the various courses of said branch to William Hargrave's line thence along said line
 N. 87. E. 35 p. to a corner white oak S. 49. E. 44 pole to a corner pond N. 87. E. 17. 9. pole to a
 corner post oak on the path in said John Hargrave's line thence along said line
 and path S. 35. E. 35 b pole to the N.E. corner to have and to hold the above named
 tract premises together with all and singular the appurtenances conveniences &
 profits to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said William
 R Battie his heirs and assigns forever and the said Nicholas Mugt to have
 his heirs executors administrators or assigns with covenant and agree to and with the said
 William R Battie his heirs executors or assigns forever that he the said Nicholas
 Mugt his heirs and assigns will warrant and forever defend the right and title to the
 above granted premises to the said William R Battie his heirs and assigns against all
 lawful claim or demands from any person or persons whatever In witness whereof
