This Indenture made this seventeenth day of August one thousand Eight hundred and twenty  
Between Matt Browne of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and  
of the same County and State of the second part and Joseph Tilton of the County of Southampton  
State of Virginia of the third part and witness the said Matt Browne  
Honorable witness by a note of hand to the said James Scott in the sum of thirty five dollars  
and thirty three cents Current money of the United States of America and witness for the purpose  
appearance of the payment it is agreed by the parties hereto that a conveyance in trust  
is made unto the said Joseph Tilton for the benefit of the said James Scott of the  
sum on the Note aforesaid shall not be punctually paid with lawful interest thereon  
before the first day of December next now This Indenture witness establish  
Matt Browne for and in consideration of the premises and for the further sum of  
one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt of which is acknowledged with hand and seal  
and by these presents doth for himself his heirs Executor and administrator give grant barg  
and sell unto the said Joseph Tilton his heirs and assigns one Horse two Cattle and  
their increase one Cow and one heifer of Catt. wheels one feather bed and furniture  
Eight bags and one box and pigs and their increase Cakes 2 Wheed and 3 ploughs  
3 horses and to hold the aforesaid granted and bargained premises unto the said Joseph Tilton  
his heirs and assigns in trust forever and it is hereby declared to be the true intent and meaning  
of these presents that if the said Matt Browne shall punctually pay to the said James Scott  
his heirs and assigns the sum of thirty five dollars and thirty three cents and interest agree  
able to the time of the said Note to the said James Scott then the said Joseph Tilton  
his heirs and assigns shall hold the property above granted to the sole and entire use and benefit  
of the said Matt Browne and the said Joseph Tilton covenants and agrees with the  
parties hereto that if the said Matt Browne his heirs Executor and Administrator shall  
to make payment to the said James Scott his heirs and assigns on or before the 1<sup>st</sup>  
day of December next the sum due on the note aforesaid that then the said Joseph  
Tilton his heirs and assigns shall stand seized of the above granted and bargained  
premises for the sum of one hundred dollars to say that is to say that at the time  
of the said James Scott his heirs and assigns the said Joseph Tilton his heirs
