This Indenture made and entered into on the 21st day of February in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty nine between Mills Johnson of the first part Joseph Jordan Trustee of the second part and Richard Jordan of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas the said Mills Johnson stands justly indebted unto the said Richard Jordan by Bond date on the 23rd day of January 1829 and payable twelve months after date for the sum of two hundred dollars with the interest thereon accruing the said Mills Johnson is willing and desirous to secure Mr. Fred Johnson (therefor) Witnesses that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar lawful money of Virginia to the said Mills Johnson in hand paid by the said Joseph Jordan Trustee at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Mills Johnson he hath given granted bargained sold aliened conveyed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien convey release confirm to the said Joseph Jordan Trustee his heirs Executors and Administrators forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate by and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Lukes containing by late survey Ninety acres be the same more or less the boundaries of which will appear by referring to the deed of Benjamin Clark and others to the said Mills Johnson for the said Ninety acres of land which said deed is now in the Clerk's Office together with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the Estate right title and interest of the said Mills Johnson in and to the said tract or parcel of land and premises thereunto granted or intended to be truly granted To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances unto the said Joseph Jordan Trustee his heirs Executors and Administrators forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Joseph Jordan Trustee his heirs Executors and Administrators forever and the said Mills Johnson for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators doth hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Joseph Jordan Trustee his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the said tract or parcel of land and premises both conveyed and every part or parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever now or hereafter made or claimed that the said Joseph Jordan Trustee his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns shall provide the said Mills Johnson to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging and take the proper steps to his own use until default be made in the payment of the aforesaid sum of Two hundred dollars either in whole or in part and the interest accruing thereon and that when the same shall be due the said Joseph Jordan or his legal representatives whom he shall by public request be to the said Richard Jordan or Mills Johnson or either of them legal representatives shall call at public Auction for ready money the said tract or parcel of land and premises and
