This Indenture made and executed on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of February in the year of  
Our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty nine between Mills Johnson of the first part and Joseph  
Jordan Trustee of the second part and Richard Jordan of the third part all of the  
County of Southampton and State of Virginia WITNESCH that whereas the said  
Mills Johnson stands greatly in debt unto the said Richard Jordan by Rent Day  
date on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 1829 and payable twelve months after date for the  
sum of two hundred dollars which debt with the interest thereon according to the said  
Mills Johnson is owing and desirous to secure Mr. Edw. Dill therefore  
WITNESCH that for and in Consideration of the premises and ales for the full  
consideration of the sum of one dollar lawful money of Virginia to the said  
Mills Johnson in hand paid by the said Joseph Jordan Trustee at and before  
the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge  
he the said Mills Johnson having given grants bargained sold aliened encumbered  
and performed and by these presents doth give and grant to the said Joseph Jordan  
Conform to the said Joseph Jordan Trustee his heirs Executors and Administrators  
forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid town  
of Southampton and Parish of St. Luke containing by late survey Ninety acres of the same  
more or less the boundaries of which will appear by referring to the deed of Benjamin Dill  
and others to the said Mills Johnson for the said Ninety acres of land which did at the time  
in the Clerks Office together with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract of land  
of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the Estate Right Title and interest  
of the said Mills Johnson in and to the said tract or parcel of land and premises  
granted or intended to be hereby granted To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of  
land and premises with its appurtenances unto the said Joseph Jordan Trustee  
his heirs Executors and Administrators forever to and for the only proper use and behoof  
of him the said Joseph Jordan his heirs Executors and Administrators forever and the said  
Mills Johnson for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators hereby covenant promise and  
agree to and with the said Joseph Jordan Trustee his heirs Executors Administrators  
affirms that he will by these presents to amount and power defend the right and title of the  
said tract or parcel of land and premises fully, clearly and every part or parcel thereof  
against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever upon such  
time nevertheless that the said Joseph Jordan Trustee his heirs Executors Administrators  
shall permit the said Mills Johnson to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the said tract or  
parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereunto belonging and take the profits thereof  
to his own use until default be made in the payment of the aforesaid sum of Ninety dollars  
either in whole or in part and the interest according theron and when upon his failure and  
the said Joseph Jordan or his legal representatives wherein shall be the debts required by him  
the said Richard Jordan or Mills Johnson or either of them legal representatives  
at public Auction for ready money the said tract or parcel of land and premises
