of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful money
granted to the said Nathaniel Blom paid by the said John Barnes at and before the delivery
of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the said Nathaniel
Blom hath given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed unto the
said Theron Lee his executors and administrators and afflgs forever all and singular his
lands with his grant bargains aliened enfeoffed release and confirm to the said John Barnes
his executors and afflgs forever the following negro slaves to wit, Long Charles, and brother and all the
estate rights title and interest of the said Nathaniel Blom in and to the said grants or unto
to be granted negro slaves to wit, Long Charles and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be
granted negro slaves unto the said John Barnes his executors and administrators and afflgs for
to the only use and behoof of the said John Barnes his executors and administrators
afflgs forever and the said Nathaniel Blom for himself his executors and administrators
will make and promis and agrees to and with the said John Barnes his executors and afflgs
afflgs forever in manner and form following that is to say the aforesaid negro slaves Long Charles &
others his executors and administrators the aforesaid negro slaves Long Charles & others
unto the said John Barnes his executors and administrators and afflgs against all just
whatever shall and will evant and occur defind by these presents Upon this
