In witness and agree that he will make satisfy the right and interest hereby conveyed for the best price he can obtain for the same after advertising the same and places for ten days previous at some public house or store in the said County and with the money arising from the said first pay and sales first pay attending the same as well as the expense attending the said conveyance and then pay off the aforesaid debt and interest to the said John Wigham and then pay the overplus if any to the said Joseph Samuel and the said Thaddeus Boykin on his part.
