That Indenture made and entered into the 19 day of September in the Eleventh
Year one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Henry Barrow of the first part and
John Salathiel Francis and John Barrow of the second part and Robert Edmund Mudgegrave of the
third part chosen as Mediators of the said first part all of the County of Southampton and City
of Basingstoke. Witness that whereas Salathiel Francis and John Barrow have
become security in four forth coming Bonds for the said Henry Barrow bearing date as follows
one to Benjamin Turner Curator of James and Elizabeth Turner for the sum of Three Hundred
two dollars and 70c. entitling to a credit on the forth coming Bond of two hundred and twenty eight
dollars and 35/100. bearing date on the 24th July 1829. one due George A. Mudgegrave of
Lymington bearing date from 10th September 1829. for eighty one dollar and 71/100 one to
Benjamin Turner and of Charles Turner dec^d for the sum of Fifty four dollars and 29/100
bearing date as is in the above one due to J. E. Carter and of Leonard Rice dec^d who has for the said
William bearing date 10th September 1829. for one hundred and twenty dollar and 63/100
and one due to Charles Magid for forty three dollar and 75/100. and bearing date as is in the above
and whereas the said Salathiel Francis and John Barrow have become security in three Bonds to
John Thomas and with the said annuity of Benjamin Barrow dec^d and Henry Barrow
19th 1828 one payable September 19th 1829. and one payable September 19th 1830. The
amount of each Bond being one hundred and one dollar and 25/100. and the said Henry Barrow
in order to have the payment of the above forth coming Bonds and Bonds and annuities
Salathiel Francis and John Barrow as his securities and in consideration of the sum of one
dollar in hand paid to the said Henry Barrow by the said Robert Mudgegrave the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged the said Henry Barrow hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents
doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Robert Mudgegrave the following property to wit the
woman Madam one girl Diana one woman Mary and one negro man Elham one negro boy
George together with all his Port of Port Cotton and Fadder two horses all his stock of Cattle
Pigs and hogs one pig Cows and all his farming utensils one deer Board one secretary two
looking glasses one feather Bed and furniture one blanket one dining table one negro woman
Chant together with all the household and kitchen furniture and every part and parcel thereof
and all his interest in or out of the said property To have and To hold unto the said
Mudgegrave his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever Upon Trust nevertheless that
the said Robert Mudgegrave shall as soon as the aforesaid forth coming Bonds are paid
or as soon as the above Salathiel Francis and John Barrow or either of them shall think
themselves in danger or likely to suffer or on being notified by either party shall proceed to sell
the property before mentioned to the highest bidder for cash after giving ten days notice of the
time and place of sale and out of the money arising therefrom pay off the debts due
before mentioned interest and costs and the costs and charges attending such sale shall first
satisfied and the residue of the money to be applied to the payment of the following Bonds
in the order in which they are mentioned. Viz One to Benjamin Turner Curator of James and
Elizabeth Turner for thirty eight dollars & 75/100 due on the 25th Decr 1829. One claim due
to J. E. Carter on the Clerk's office amount and date not recollect and one due
Benjamin Turner Curator of James and Elizabeth Turner for thirty two dollars and
5/100 due 20th April 1829 one due the Estate of William Stand dec^d for thirty dollars due
October 1828. and one due the Estate of William Stand dec^d for twenty dollar and 71/100
due the 10th of September 1828. and all debts that have been contracted and the
residue of any and every from such sale as aforesaid to be paid to the use of the said Henry Barrow
his Executors and assigns or to such person or persons as he shall appoint to receive the same
for which whereof we have been and are and will be and do hereby certify and acknowledge
