 Selwry Norton his Executor admors heirs and assigns all my right and interest in the dower lands of
 my Mother in Law Elizabeth Jones of Brunswick County including the negroes together
 with their increase which were lent to her the said Elizabeth by the will and bequest of my father
 James Barnes deceased with all and singular the several rights to which I am entitled by said will
 of what nature so ever without exception To have and to hold unto the said Selwry
 Norton and his heirs forever against the claim or claim of all and every person or persons who
 ever shall and lawfully demand and demand by the said presents. In witness whereof I have

 that the said Thomas E. Porter for and in consideration of one dollar to him on hand paid by the
 said Patrick Ford the receipt whereof the said Thomas E. Porter do hereby acknowledge
 have granted bargained and sold and made over to the said Patrick Ford and by these presents doth
 grant bargain sell ~~make~~ make over to the said Ford as follows the following property (to wit) two
 feather beds and furniture two iron chests two iron tables half dozen sitting chairs two iron
 pots one oven skillets and spurs two axes two hoes and all the Crockery ware of every descrip-
 tion one spinning wheel shawl and Tonge One Corn and two Hogs To have and to hold the
 aforementioned property unto the said Patrick Ford his heirs and assigns forever and the said
 Thomas E. Porter for himself his heirs and assigns and the aforesaid property to the said Patrick
 Ford and shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend upon Just Demand that whereas
 the said Thomas E. Porter stands bound and acknowledge a honest justly indebted to
 the said Benjamin Branch in and for the just sum of forty eight dollars a greuable to
 a note which the said Porter has assigned to the said Branch bearing this day and
 date above written and the said Patrick Ford shall cause after being notified by said
 Branch or Porter shall sell or cause to be sold so much of the aforementioned property as will
 be sufficient to discharge the above mentioned debt of forty eight dollars and interest
 thereon and necessary expenses The sale aforesaid to be made upon the request of Thomas
 E. Porter or said Benjamin Branch giving by advertisement ten days notice of the time and
 place of the said sale and the said Patrick Ford shall pay unto the said Thomas E. Porter
 after the sale the balance if any after paying the aforesaid debt and necessary
