This Indenture made and entered into this 21st day of September 1829 in and between
Margaret Wells of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the first part and William
E. Lawrence of the same County and State of the second and William Lawrence of the same
County and State of the third part witnesseth that whereas the said Margaret
Wells stands greatly indebted unto the said William E. Lawrence in the first and full
sum of fifty dollars lawful money of Virginia which appears by note executed by the said
Margaret Wells and made payable the 28th day of January 1829 now due
Margaret Wells being desirous to indemnify and hence the payment of the sum
mentioned debt more especially for the sum of One dollar to her husband by the said
William Lawrence before the concluding and delivering of these presents which
is hereby acknowledged that the said Margaret Wells had granted her
bold unto the said William Lawrence three feather beds and furniture on trust
Mar. and Oct. and few head of cattle to him and his heirs forever upon the following
Trust, to-w^r, that if the said Margaret Wells shall fail to pay and discharge
the above debt when requested by the said William E. Lawrence it shall be the duty
of the said William Lawrence so soon as requested in writing from under the hand
of William E. Lawrence his executors administrators or assigns to let up and sell for cash etc
before mentioned property or so much as will be sufficient to pay the debt then due
and pay to the said William E. Lawrence the debt that is due to him with all the
just damages to this Trust and the surplus if any may over to the said Margaret
Wells his heirs or assigns. In Estm^{ry} wherof we the parties have set our hands
