 Mills had justly indebted into the said William & Lawrence in the just and full
 sum of fifty dollars lawful money of Virginia which appears by note executed by the said
 Margaret Mills and made payable the 28th day of January 1829. and the said
 Margaret Mills being desirous to indemnify and secure the payment of the before
 mentioned debt more especially for the sum of one dollar to her said husband the said
 William Lawrence before the entering and delivering of these presents where
 is hereby acknowledged that she the said Margaret Mills hath granted bargain
 sold unto the said William Lawrence three feather Beds and furniture on wheels
 more and Bolt and five head of cattle to him and his heirs forever upon the following
 Trust (Viz) that if she the said Margaret Mills shall fail to pay and discharge
 the above debt when requested by the said William & Lawrence it shall be the duty
 of the said William Lawrence so soon as requested in writing from under the hand
 of William & Lawrence his executors admorsors assigns to set up and sell for cash the
