No 3 This Indenture made the 1st day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Harrison Dyer of Southampton County of the one part and James Morris of the same County of the other part. witnesseth that the said Harrison Dyer for and in consideration of the sum of sixteen dollars and forty cents to him in hand paid by the said James Morris the receipt of which he hereby acknowledges hath granted to him and his heirs and assigns sold all land in his possession and by these presents doth grant to him and his heirs and assigns land unto the said James Morris to him and his heirs and assigns forever. One certain tract or parcel of land being one of the Oldmores tract and lying southwesterly of his house containing by estimation twenty acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a red oak on Bryants line then running by Bryants house a maple a corner in the branch then down the branch to a dogwood a corner in the said line Morris line thence along said Morris line to a corner in the said line so far as the first station together with all houses and buildings upon ground or in way waters and water courses whatsoever belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the said lands and premises unto the said James Morris to him and his heirs forever. And whereas Archibald Drake or his wife for himself and his heirs doth forever warrant defend the right of said tract of land unto the said James Morris and his heirs forever. Examined and acknowledged by the other party. witnesseth that the said Archibald Drake and Patsey doth to Matthew Drake consideration of the just and full sum of Three hundred and nineteen dollars and the 5th day of October Seventy two cents current money of the United States of America in hand paid the date 1832 of which is hereby acknowledged and the said Archibald Drake and Patsey his wife have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant to him and all unto the said Matthew Drake and to his heirs and assigns forever in all that tract of land wherein the said Archibald Drake now lies being the same tract or part of land which the said Archibald Drake bought of Barnaby Drake by Indenture bearing date the 20th day of January one thousand eight hundred containing by estimation two hundred acres being some more or less bounded by the known and reputed bounds thereto also all the buildings wares wainwrights and appurtenances to the same belonging and herrecomend rents issues and profits thereof and all the estate whatsoever of the said Archibald Drake and Patsey his wife of and to the said Matthew Drake to hold the said tract or parcel of land unto the said Matthew Drake his heirs and assigns forever. And only proprietors and heirs of the said Matthew Drake his heirs and assigns forever. And the said A. Archibald Drake and Patsey his wife shall have and retain to them their executors and administrators the said tract or parcel of land with all and every the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Matthew Drake his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and defend the same by these presents.
