This Indenture made and entered into on the 27th day of March in the 5th year of our Lord Edward the 7th King of Great Britain between William Bryant of the County of Northampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Jacob Barnett of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Bryant for and in consideration of the sum of sixty pounds and fifty Cents current money of the Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnett at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledges hath granted bargained and sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell aliened conveyed and confirmed unto him the said Jacob Barnett his heirs and assigns forever One Certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying being in the aforesaid County of Northampton and Parish of Saint Pauls containing by late survey six and one fourth acres and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a corner made for said William Bryant near a small branch in said Jacob Barnett's line thence along said Jacob Barnett's line A 84 M 34 poles to a Spruce standing near the road thence up the road same course A 84 M 16 poles thence A 62 1/2 poles to a large red oak standing near said road a new corner for said William Bryant thence along a new line of marked trees 165 6 7/8 poles to the center of four trees oaks a corner thence S 75 M 3 poles to the Beginning To give to all eight the interest claim or demand of us and to the said tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appurtenant To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances to him the said Jacob Barnett his heirs and assigns forever for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Jacob Barnett his heirs and assigns And the said William Bryant for himself has been executor administrator and assignee of the said Joseph Miller and agrees to and with the said Jacob Barnett his heirs and assigns that he will by these presents give and forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and every part and parcel thereof against the claim or demand of all and every person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the said William Bryant hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and date first within written
