said James Cooper for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars
good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William Bratton the receipt
whereof the said James Cooper doth acknowledge himself fully and completely satisfied and paid
and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alway and forever unto the said William
Bratton his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate
lying and being in the County of Southampton and Parish of Stowey Containing by estimation
fifty acres or the same more or less and bounded as follows Beginning
at a white pine stump standing in a glasse line running thence east 27° E 60.
pole to a sapwooded oak corner of Schabod Johnston and Schabod Cooper and thence
N 47° M 50' pole to a small branch thence N 57° W 88 pole to a large pine on the side of the
small branch thence down the said branch 170 M 73 pole to a tree corner of Schabod
Murdough and Schabod Johnston thence S 54° W 44 pole to the road thence up the same
