Col. David This Indenture made and entered into the 9th day of October one thousand eight
 hundred and twenty nine in and between Severin Hollans of the County of Southampton
 and State of Virginia of the first part and Jesse Parker of the same County and State of
 the second part and Lemuel Daugherty of the same County and State of the third part
 Witness that whereas the said Severin Hollans stands partly indebted and the
 said Jesse Parker in the first term of the Summer last sixty four dollars and 33 Cents
 lawful money of Virginia which appears by Bond bearing date with these presents
 and made payable from the said Severin. Now the said Severin Hollans being
 desirous to indemnify and secure the payment of the above debt, not more necessary
 for the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by him the said Lemuel Daugherty
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, viz, that the said Severin Hollans hath granted bargained and sold
 and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell to him the said Lemuel Daugherty
 his heirs and assigns forever one Certain tract or parcel of Land, lying and being in the
 aforesaid County and State, containing One Acre and Acres to the same more or less and also
 by the lands of Meredith Hollans of said County and State of Virginia and others
 being the same tract of land he the said Severin Hollans purchased of Taylor Lewis
 which appears by deed executed by him and his wife Temperance Edwards and on record
 in the Clerk's Office of the County to him the said Lemuel Daugherty his heirs and
 assigns forever upon the following Trust, viz, that if the said Severin Hollans should
 fail to pay and discharge the above mentioned debt and all costs pertaining to the tract
 it shall be lawful and right in that event for him the said Lemuel Daugherty to and
 requested in writing from him the said Jesse Parker his heirs or assigns to deliver up
 the said land after giving public notice by advertisement to be sold at
 different places in the neighborhood of the said land at least twenty days before
 the day of sale and out of the money so raised first pay the debt above mentioned
 and all costs pertaining to the tract and the surplus if any pay over to him the said
 Severin Hollans his heirs or assigns In Testimony whereof we the parties
