 for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to my son Henry
 Harris of said County as well as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to me
 in hand paid by the said Henry Harris at or before the instaling and delivery of these
 presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I have given and granted and by
 these presents do give and grant unto the said Henry Harris his heirs and assigns
 forever all that tract or parcel of Land that I am charged of by the Draper Containing
 twenty four acres more or less and bounded by the lands of Sgt. Rogers Com. Turner
 Matthew Williams the heirs of John Adams and Elizabeth Biles reference to former
 Deeds being had well more fully appear To have and to hold the said twenty
 four acres of land together with all the premises and appurtenances therunto
 belonging or in anywise appertaining to the same or any part or part thereof
 unto him the said Henry Harris his heirs and assigns forever and the said
 Joseph Harris for himself his heirs and assigns the said land unto the said
 Henry Harris his heirs and assigns forever against the claim or claims of him the
 said Joseph Harris his heirs or assigns and against the claim or claims of all
 and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend
