This Indenture made and entered into this 30th day of October 1829 between
Charles W Scott and Ellen his wife of the Parish of Northway and County of North-
ampton of the one part and Richard Mons of said County and Parish of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Charles W Scott and Ellen his wife for and in consideration
of the just and full sum of six hundred and fifty dollars current money of Virginia to
them paid by the said Richard Mons have bargained and sold and by their presents
do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Richard Mons his heirs
and assigns a certain tract of land containing by estimation two hundred and twenty
acres or the same more or less being the tract formerly purchased by Miles Shonson
of the Commissioners appointed to sell the lands of Christopher Calvert and divided
by said Miles Shonson to Ehabor Shonson and purchased of him by Charles W
Scott and bounded by the known and reputed bounds thereof together with the woods
and reversions remainder and Remainder yearly and then said of part and profit among
part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said tract of land with the woods
hereditaments and all and singular the other premises herein before mentioned or which
to be bargained and sold and is now part and parcel thereof with any of them before
mentioned and appurtenant unto the said Richard Mons his heirs and assigns forever
And the said Charles W Scott and Ellen his wife for themselves and their heirs said
tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto
the said Richard Mons his heirs and assigns free from the claim of them the said Charles
W Scott and Ellen his wife or either of them or their heirs and heirs and every person
whatsomever shall arise and do warrant and for or defend by these presents in witness
