 and assigns a certain Lot and parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton
 and adjoining the lands of the above named William Butler lying nearly a north west
 corner and near the present dwelling house of him the said Butler and bounded by the eastern
 edge of the Cypress Swamp from where the above named parcel line crosses said Road to where
 said Road comes to said parties line again then back the said parties line to the beginning
 which boundaries are supposed to contain one and a fourth acres of Land together with
 all the right title and interest and Estate of in and to the above described Lot and parcel
 of Land to him the said William Butler his heirs and assigns forever To have and
 to hold the said Lot of Land with the Tenements hereunto and all and singular
 other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every
