money of this Commonwealth to him in hand by the said William Butler at or before the  
ensuing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledge doth give  
and sell and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said William Butler his heirs  
and assigns a certain Lot and parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton  
and adjoining the lands of the above named William Butler lying nearly a south west  
Bordre and near the present dwelling house of him the said Butler and bounded by the eastwardly  
edge of the Express road from whence the above named part of the Road leadeth to where  
such road cometh to said parties line again then back the said partition to the Beginning  
which boundaries are supposed to containe one and a fourth acres of Land together with  
all the right title and interest and Estate of any and to the above described lot and parcel  
of Land to him the said William Butler his heirs and assigns forever To have and  
to hold the said Lot of Land with the Tenements hereditaments and all and singular  
other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every  
part and parcel thereof unto said William Butler his heirs and assigns forever to come  
for the only proprieate and behoef of him the said William Butler his heirs and  
assigns forever And the said Jacob Barnes for himself and his heirs during  
his and parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances  
before mentioned unto the said William Butler his heirs and assigns free from all claim

acknowledgeth hath granted bargained and sold aliened and parted and confirmed and by these  
presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Jacob  
Barnes his heirs and assigns forever one certaine piece or parcel of Land situated lying  
and being in the County aforesaid of Southampton and Parish of St. Luke & Con-  
taining by estimation one and one fourth acre the same more or less and bounded
