This Indenture made this 23rd day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty nine betwix Drury C. Waller and Eleanor Waller his wife both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Drury Walle of the said County and State of the other part. Wherein the said Drury C. Waller and Eleanor his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars in hand paid to them by the said Drury Walle the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do give grant sell and convey and by these presents do give grant sell confirm and convey unto the said Drury Walle one part or equal proportions of Land that fell unto the said Drury C. Waller and Eleanor his wife from the same lands of Drury Walle accesse to certain forty acres be the same more or less together with all woods unadvised water and water courses hedges and orchards with all the privileges therein belonging or in any way appertaining to have and to hold the same unto the said Drury Walle his heirs and assigns to him them their heirs and assigns forever and we Drury C. Waller and Eleanor his wife do covenant to and with the said Drury Walle his heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee of the premises that are free of all incumbrances And that we will warrant and forever defend the just right and title of all the appurtenances unto the said Drury Walle his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claim and demand of all persons whatever. *In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals this 23rd day of October above written*
