Waller and Eleanor his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars in hand paid to them by the said Drury Wills the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do give grant sell and convey and by these presents doth give grant sell confirm and convey unto the said Drury Wills one part or equal proportion of land that fell unto the said Drury C. Waller and Eleanor his wife from the same lands of the said Drury Wills accuse to contain forty acres be the same more or less together with all woods in and wood water and water courses houses and or churds with all the privileges thereunto belonging or in any way appertaining to have and to hold the same unto the said Drury Wills his heirs and assigns to him them and their heirs behoof forever and we Drury C. Waller and Eleanor his wife do covenant to and with the said Drury Wills his heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee of the premises that are free of all incumbrances And that we will warrant and forever defend the just right and title of all the appurtenances unto the said Drury Wills his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claim and demand of all persons whatever. *In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals* *Thru day & date above written*
