 of three hundred and twenty five dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them
 in hand paid by the said Doct. L. C. Ferguson at or before the executing of these presents
 the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these
 presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Doct. L. C. Ferguson
 his heirs and assigns a certain house and lot adjoining to the town of Cambridge
 in the said County formerly the property of the Estate of Doct. Force together with
 all and singular the appurtenances and the reversions and reversions remaines and
 remainders of realty and other tenements and profits thereof and of every part and
 parcel thereof To have and to hold the said house and lot with the ten-
 ements thereunto and all and singular thereto premises herein before mentioned
 or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every
 of them right minims and appurtenances unto the said Doct. L. C. Ferguson his
 heirs and assigns forever And the said Sargant Bryant and Elizabeth his wife for
 themselves and their heirs the said house and lot with all and singular the premises
 and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Doct. L. C. Ferguson his heirs &
