 of three hundred and twenty four dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him
 in hand paid by the said Doct P C Bryant at or before the sealing of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these
 presents do and each of them doth convey and sell unto the said Doct P C Bryant
 his heirs and assigns a certain house and lot adjoining to the town of Embden
 in the said County formerly the property of the Estate of Sect Price together with
 all and singular the appurtenances and the revenue and reversions belonging and
 remaining yearly and other rents charges and profits thereof and of every part and
 parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said house and lot with the ten-
 ments thereabouts and all and singular other the premises hereinbefore mentioned
 or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with way
 of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Doct P C Bryant his
 heirs and assigns forever And the said Augustus Bryant and Elizabeth his wife for
