That Indenture made this 26th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and twenty, between James McKelvie and Mary his wife of the County of South-
 ampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John Darden of the County of Stafford
 and State of North Carolina of the other part Witnesseth that the said James McKelvie and
 Mary his wife in consideration of three thousand and no more five dollars of lawful
 money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said John Darden at or
 before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them do bargain
 and sell unto the said John Darden his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel
 of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded by
 the lands of the following named persons, to wit, by the land of William Allen
 and Mathias Williams being the land that Isaac Williams formerly owned
 on and supposed to contain one hundred and twenty five acres more or less together
 with all improvements thereon together with all privileges profits commodities advan-
 tages emolument, hereditaments and appurtenances in and to the said land lying
 in or appertaining with all the right title interest and Estate to him the said
 John Darden his heirs and assigns forever To have and to hold the said tract or
 parcel of land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises
 before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with
 every other right unto the said John Darden his heirs and assigns forever to and for
 the only proper use and behoof of them the said John Darden his heirs and assigns
 forever and the said James McKelvie and Mary his wife for themselves and
 their heirs the said parcel or tract of land with all and singular the premises and
 appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John Darden his heirs and assigns
 free from the claims or claims of them the said James McKelvie and Mary his
 wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons
 who may have or shall claim and do claim and for ever defend by these presents
 Witnesseth whereof the said James McKelvie and Mary his wife have hereunto set
 their hands and seals this day and Year first above written
