 F. Doyal in order to secure the payment of the following debt Vizt, one certain obligation
 under the hand and seal of the said Augustus F. Doyal executed to wit Francis is the
 5th day of December 1829 as above stated for the sum of One hundred dollars on the following
 and sell unto the said Thomas Harris the following property to wit one parcel more
 two fields and farmstead and all my household and kitchen furniture & also
 my bridle saddle & all my cow and fodder stock of Crops &c To have and take
 the said Augustus F. Doyal ^{and his property} ~~permitted~~ unto him the said Thomas Harris his heirs and assigns
 forever upon trust nevertheless and upon this express condition that if
 the said Augustus F. Doyal shall fail to make true and faithful payment of the
 debt above mentioned on or before the 25th day of December next with interest and
 cost that may accrue thereon then in that case the said James Harris as
 Trustee to this Indenture at the request of the said James Harris shall after having
 advertised the time and place of sale at least fifteen days previous thereto proceed to
 the property herein before mentioned to the highest bidder for ready money and out of
 the money arising from such sale in the first place pay and satisfy all reason-
 able charges attending such sale and then the debt above mentioned and the balance
 of the money if any arising from such sale as aforesaid to the use of the said
 Augustus F. Doyal his legal Executor administration and assigns or to such person
 or persons as he by writing under his hand shall appoint and empower ^{within for the} full
 appointment to person or persons as aforesaid shall be entitled by virtue of his direction
