

Clement Rochelle is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 1st day of December 1829. to take effect from the expiration of the term of the present Sheriff and to continue in office until the first Quarterly Court to be holden for the said County in the Year one thousand eight hundred and thirty one. If therefore the said Clement Rochelle shall well and truly collect all dues and fees or rates and account for and pay the same in such manner as is by the Commonwealth in the said County and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Treasurer of the Commonwealth for the time being for the use of the Commonwealth in like manner as is or shall be directed in case of public Taxes and shall in all other things truly and faithfully execute the Office of Sheriff during his Continuance therein then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Clement Rochelle is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the Governor under seal of the Commonwealth dated the 1st day of December 1829 for one year from March next. If therefore the said Clement Rochelle shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the Taxes imposed by Law and all charges of Taxes due in the said County of Southampton as well and faithfully collect account for and pay the Militia fines due in the said County of Southampton aforesaid and all charges of Militia fines due in the said County and shall in all other things truly and faithfully execute the said Office of Sheriff during his Continuance therein then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
