 Lewis Alexander Esq. have bound Thomas Kieley and Robert Gorman as they are
 firmly bound unto William Robert Esq. Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth
 of Virginia in the first and full term of Thirty Thousand Dollars to be paid to the
 said Governor and his successor for the use of the Commonwealth for the payment whereof
 well and truly to be made without order and each of us on and each of our heirs
 Executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed
 with our seals and dated this 1st day of December 1829

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Clement
 Rochelle is constituted and appointed Sheriff of Southampton by a Commission from
 the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 1st day of December 1829
 for the Term of one Year from March next. If therefore the said Clement
 Rochelle shall well and truly collect and receive all officers fees and dues within the
 County to collect and duly account for and pay the same to the officers to whom such
 fees are due respectively at such times as are prescribed and limited by Law and shall
 well and truly execute and due return make of process and process to him directed
 and pay and satisfy all sum of money and Tobacco by him received by virtue of any
 such process to the person or persons to whom the same are due his or their Executors
 administrators or assigns And in all other things truly and faithfully execute and
 perform the said Office of Sheriff during the term of his continuance therein
 the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue
 signed sealed and delivered

This Indenture made this 5th day of January in the Year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and thirty between Alfred Denson of the County of
 Southampton of the one part and William Blaines of the same County of the other
 part Witnesseth that the said Alfred Denson for and in consideration of the sum
 of Eighty dollars lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said William
 Blaines at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged by the said Alfred Denson and every part and parcel thereof
 doth clearly exonerate acquit and discharge the said William Blaines his heirs
 assigns & assigns and every of them forever by these presents he the said Alfred Denson
 hath bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
 bargain sell and confirm unto the said William Blaines his heirs and assigns forever
 all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County and the
 appurtenances thereto containing by estimation fifty acres in the same more or less more
 bounded as follows beginning at the road at a stone fence a corner tree in said William
 Blaines' line thence a line of marked trees to a gum in a branch in William Blaines' line
 thence a line of marked trees in said Blaine's line to a spruce pine a corner in said
 Blaine's line thence a line of marked trees to a spruce pine a corner in said
 Williams' line at the road thence down the road to the first Station with all right
 title of the said tract of land and premises hereby granted or mentioned and every
