to Markode Tate the said Alexander T. Tate do hereby acknowledge hath granted conveyed sold and by
Tate the 2nd these presents hath grant conveyed and convey to the said Markode Tate his heirs and
day of March assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred and twenty six acres
1831 be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of David Price Thomas Applewhite
and others it being the tract of Land purchased by Edward Reese from the heirs of Isaac
Reese and sold at said Reese's sale by the said A. T. Tate ad. and purchased by Markode
Tate as public Auction for the consideration aforesaid with all and singular
the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Markode Tate
his heirs and assigns forever and the said A. T. Tate ad. for himself and his heirs by
ad. do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Markode Tate his heirs and
assigns and that he the said Alexander T. Tate ad. and his assigns the said tract of
Land with its appurtenances unto him the said Markode Tate his heirs and assigns
against them the said A. T. Tate ad. and his assigns against all and every person
or persons whatsoever shall vice and do warrants and defend. In witness whereof
