This Indenture made and entered into this the 18 day of December in the Year one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Josiah Tungason of the County of Jenkins State of Virginia of the one part and Levi Tungason of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty six Dollars in hand paid to the said Josiah Tungason the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that the said Josiah Tungason hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto him the said Levi Tungason all right title property and interest which the said Josiah Tungason has or ever hereafter may have in and to a certain tract or parcel of Land formerly belonging to his father Josiah Tungason lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation ten and four sevenths acres be the same more or less To have and to hold unto him the said Levi Tungason his heirs and assigns forever and the said Josiah Tungason for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators doth by these presents transfer and convey quit claims to the said tract or parcel of Land unto the said Levi Tungason and his heirs forever and doth by these presents agree to warrant and forever defend all right title property and interest in and to the said Land unto him the said Levi Tungason his heirs and assigns forever In Testimony of which the said Josiah Tungason hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day before written

This Indenture made this 5 day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine between Joseph Edmon of the County of Southampton of the one part and Jordan Edwards of the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said Joseph Edmon for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and forty two dollars containing of Virginia in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Jordan Edwards and to his heirs and assigns all the plantation tract and parcel of Land in the County of Southampton which Benjamin Beale dec^d conveyed and conveyed unto the said Joseph Edmon by a Deed in Trust bearing date the 11 day of January 1823 To have the payment of a Debt due to James Beale containing by estimation eight acres be the same more or less and is bounded by the River and the River down as there of being all the tract of Land belonging to the said Benjamin Beale dec^d whereas the said Levi and also all the buildings urrens waters advantages and appurtenances unto the same belonging To have and to hold the said tract of Land unto the said Jordan Edwards his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Jordan Edwards his heirs and assigns forever And the said Joseph Edmon his heirs Executors and Administrators doth by these presents transfer and convey quit claims to the said tract or parcel of Land with all and every the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Jordan Edwards his heirs and assigns against and against all claiming or demanding the same from for by or under him Heirs and assigns Warrants and for ever defend by these presents With Testimony whereof the
