 of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that we the said Comission-
 er for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Fifty dollars to us in hand
 paid paid by the said Mary Parker the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 we the said Commissioners have bargained granted and sold and by these presents grant
 bargain and sell unto the said Mary Parker to have and to hold for ever one certain
 tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County above written contain-
 Eighty acres more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a Gum at the head of the
 Raccoon Branch in 130 rods Mill Pond a corner of William L Rochelle line
 thence Southward along the said Rochelle's line to a pine a corner thence Eastward
 long the said Rochelle line to a Branch thence along a Chopped line on the branch
 to a Maple a corner on the said Rochelle line thence Westward to a pine in a
 small branch a corner on the said Rochelle line thence along the said branch to the
 head of the Mill Pond thence up the Mill Pond to the beginning To have and
 to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all the appurtenances therunto
 belonging unto the said Mary Parker to be held by her and her heirs forever and
 we the said Commissioners for ourselves and our heirs and all and every person or persons
 whosoever claiming under them shall and will warrant and defend as far as
