dollars of lawful money of Virginia to him the said John Shull in hand paid the sum
whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said John Shull hath granted bargained
sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Walter G.
Brittle his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land with improvements
containing two hundred and thirty six acres to the same more or less lying in the
County of Southampton and bounded by the lands of Richard Stephenson Patrick
Pond Kelly's Kitchen's Branches and now naming Oldishains
and also all trees woods underwood ways waters water courses profits communitie aduantages
housholdments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said above mentioned belonging or in
any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainder and remains
rents issues and profits of the said premises and of every part and parcel thereof
and all the estate right title claim and demand whatsoever of him the said John
Shull of and to the said land &c and every part thereof to have and to hold
the said Land &c above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the appur-
tenances unto the said Walter G. Brittle his heirs and assigns to the only purpose
and behoof of the said Walter G. Brittle his heirs and assigns forever. And further
John Shull for himself and his heirs the said Land &c and every part thereof
