 County of Hampshire in the State of Virginia and Abigailton Jones of the County of South-
 ampton and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said William M. Jones and
 Elizabeth Croft the Creditor for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred
 and thirty five dollars at being the amount of the debt aforesaid have granted bargained
 and released and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said Abigailton Jones all that tract or parcel of Land which the said Abigailton
 Jones conveyed to the William M. Jones as Trustee in the aforesaid deed of Trust contain-
 ing twelve hundred acres more or less adjoining the lands of the said Elizabeth Croft. Whereas
 within the hours of said Court Darius and others and by a testimony and Black Water River
 do have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land unto the her heirs and assigns and
 all and singular other the premises and appurtenances hereunto before mentioned to be truly
 granted and released with them and every of their appurtenances unto the said Abigailton
 Jones his heirs and assigns forever. And the said William M. Jones and Elizabeth Croft
 for themselves their heirs and assigns the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular
 the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining unto the said
 Abigailton Jones his heirs and assigns against the claim of them the said Wm. M.
