This Indenture made this 19th day of January 1801 between Samuel Drury of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part. Wm. A. Brown of the said County and State of the second part and Lewis Harris Commissioner appointed by the County Court of Southampton of the third part. Whereas the said Wm. A. Brown on the 24th day of December 1827 in order to secure the payment of the sum of Two Thousand Two Hundred and eighty dollars to the said Lewis Harris Commissioner 8th day by Indenture of Trust of that date conveyed to the said Samuel Drury his heirs assigns 8th the following property to wit one certain lot or parcel of land situated in the County aforesaid bounded by the lands of the said Wm. A. Brown Joseph m. E. Rains George Gray and others containing four hundred and fifty six acres upon which for the uses and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned and whereas since the executing and delivery of the said deed of Trust the said Wm. A. Brown hath fully satisfied and paid the said Harris the sum of money thereby secured where the said Harris hath hereby acknowledged that for the consideration aforesaid as well as the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Wm. A. Brown to the said Drury at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt of the said Harris is hereby acknowledged by the said Drury with the assent and approbation of the said Harris signified by his being party to these presents and the said Harris
