of the second part Witnesseth that the said James Jackson Es^r for and in consideration
of the sum of Four dollars and fifty Cents paid to him in hand paid by the said James Lee
at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said James Jackson
doth hereby acknowledge and forever acquit and discharge the said James Lee of the same
which grants bargains and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said James Lee his heirs or assigns in trust or
possession of land containing by estimation one thousand and twenty acres more or less lying
the North side of Meherrin River and known by the name of Middlebrook containing
the lands of said Lee Stillberry Mason and others It being a tract of Land the late James
Wilmington dec^d and his wife and his heirs of in the County of Southampton Virginia also the same
and reversion remainder and remainders together with all and singular the appurtenances
thereunto belonging in or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the said tract of
