 between James Jackson as Es^r of James W. McKinnon dec^d of the County of Southampton and State
 of Virginia of the first part and James Lee of the County of Halifax and State of North Carolina
 of the second part Witnesseth that the said James Jackson as Es^r for and in consideration
 of the sum of Four dollars and fifty Cents paid to him in hand paid by the said James Lee
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said James Jackson
 doth hereby acknowledge and forever acquit and discharge the said James Lee of the same
 hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth guarantee
 sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said James Lee his heirs or assigns in trust or
 portion of land containing by estimation one thousand and twenty acres more or less lying
 the North side of Meherrin River and known by the name of Middlebrook adjoining
 the lands of said Lee Littleberry Mason and others It being a tract of Land the late James
 Wilkinson dec^d and his heirs and assigns of in the County of Southampton Virginia also the same
 and reversion remainder and remainders together with all and singular the appurtenances
 thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the said Tracts parcels
 of Land together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise apper-
