This Indenture made and entered into this the 5th day of February one thousand eight hundred and
forty and between John McNeal of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the first part
James D. Bryant and Henry Kinard of the same County and State of the second part and also R.
Bryant of the County and State of the third part Whereas the said John McNeal stands greatly
indebted to the said James D. Bryant and Henry Kinard in the sum of one hundred and fifty
dollars due by Bonds one Bond executed to James D. Bryant as owner of Charles Bryant
for four dollars maturing one cent on the 22nd day of December 1829 another in favor of James
D. Bryant for fifty dollars bearing even date with this Indenture one Bond in favor of
Henry Kinard due the 11th of January 1830 for twenty one dollars and forty one cents also another
in favor of said Kinard for fifty five dollars and twenty five cents also one Bond in favor
of Everett Bryant for five dollars bearing even date with this Indenture payable on demand
the payment of which together with the interest which shall accrue thereon the said John
McNeal are willing and desirous to a give and bequeath to the said James D. Bryant and
Henry Kinard from thenceforth this Indenture witnesseth that the said John McNeal
as willing in consideration of the premises as of the sum of one dollar to him paid by
the said John R. Bryant at and before entering and delivering of these presents in full
receipt whereof is fully acknowledged and from every part of which the said John R.
Bryant and all his legal Representatives are forever released exonerated and discharged
have granted bargained and sold as hereby grant bargained and sold unto the said John R.
Bryant his heirs and assigns as follows that is to say the said John McNeal having
bargained and sold as so hereby grant bargained and sold unto the said John R. Bryant his
heirs and assigns the following property one Gun more and his increase ever since of this
and then increase born head of hogs and then increase three bed and Furniture three Chests
Tables eight Chairs two Spinning wheels and Card 1 Cradle and parcel of Plates and dishes
of Iron 3 forks 3 spoons 2 Skillets 2 Spiders together with all the household and Kitchen furniture
a parcel of Corn and fodder a parcel of meat 4 acres land weading lots 1 Gun Powder
Hunting 1000 ft. of cord 1 barrel of gunpowder 1 barrel of Plantation Intensives 100 ft. of
and to hold the said property named aforesaid and all the right title and interest and the
relation of him the said John McNeal of us and to the same to him the said John R.
Bryant his heirs etc ad infinitum forever to the only purpose and behoof of him the said
John R. Bryant forever intend notwithstanding that if the said John McNeal his heirs
etc shall and truly pay the said James D. Bryant and Henry Kinard the aforesaid sum
of £100 mentioned with interest which shall then accrue thereon or before the time he said sum
D. Bryant and Henry Kinard may or shall require the same the the contract and every thing
therein contained is to be void and of none effect but if the said John McNeal his heirs
etc shall and do not pay the said James D. Bryant and Henry Kinard the aforesaid sum
shall and do descend to the said John R. Bryant and Henry Kinard the aforesaid sum
