Wright and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty dollars & even lawful money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said John Crumpler at or before the end sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Do hereby bargain and sell and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said John Crumpler all that undivided proportion of Dower in the land formerly belonging to Eliza Noble dec'd which same is a proportion of dower in the said Thaddeus B. Wright's purchase of Eliza Noble dec'd containing more or less acres the same more or less to given with all and singular the appurtenances thereto in anywise belonging and the reversions and reversions remainder and remainders jointly and otherwise in fee simple for of the land and of every part thereof and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said parcel of land with the tenements thereto in anywise and all and singular other the premises herebefore mentioned or to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of them rights, moieties and appurtenances and unto the said John Crumpler his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thaddeus B. Wright and Nancy his wife for themselves and their heirs the said parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances herebefore mentioned unto the said John Crumpler his heirs and assigns forever from the claims or claims of them the said Thaddeus B.
